

Can you teach me how to make my own Facebook profile but without being visible to others?

Opening Facebook profile is quite simple, you just need to follow these few steps. First, you need to have **internet connection** and be connected to the device you are about to use for creating the profile. It can be your smartphone or tablet but we recommend **using laptop or computer** for better navigation and easier input of requested data. **Don't forget: your profile picture and cover photo will always be shown to the public.**

Step by Step

1. Find Facebook page following this link: www.facebook.com, or open your Facebook app (if using mobile or tablet).
2. Click on the “register” button and enter requested data - you need to fill out all the fields. We suggest reading “Terms of service” before confirming your registration.
3. You will get the confirmation code from Facebook on your e-mail (the one you entered upon registration) - open the e-mail and follow “confirm your account” button.
4. Congratulations! You succeeded to make your Facebook profile.
5. Now, you can upload your profile picture, find people you know - and you wish to have them as friends on Facebook. But before that, follow the next step.
6. Find the arrow with drop-down menu at the right top corner - go to “settings and privacy” - “check privacy settings” - “how can others find you on Facebook” - continue - “who can send you friend request” - you can choose from “everyone” and “friends of friends” - continue - who can find you via your e-mail and phone number - select from the menu the option which suits you the most - from “everyone” to “only me” (recommended) - continue - “search engines” - turn of the option.
7. There are some other suggested settings you would have to adjust before using Facebook - like who can see your personal information and things you share on your profile. You can choose from “everyone” to “only me”.
8. Update your privacy settings on regular basis and never share your password.
9. Accept only people you know in real life for your Facebook friend and follow other rules that you usually do in reality.
